A BILL

To legalize all types of abortion in the U.S. military, regardless of cause

4 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

5 This Act may be cited as the "Reproductive Care
6 for Military Women Act".

7 **SEC. 2 Guidelines**

8 Section 1093 of title 10, United States Code, is amended to
9 read— Performance of Abortions: Restrictions (a) Restriction
10 on Use of Funds.— Funds available to the Department of
11 Defense may not be used to perform abortions except where
12 the life of the mother would be endangered if the fetus were

14 of an act of rape or incest. (b) ~~Restriction on Use of~~
